One thing you should know about me before I write the rest of my review is that I rarely leave a book unfinished. I'm usually too much of a curious soul to bypass an opportunity to imagine what wacky, out-of-this-world scenario an author can come up with.

Sadly, I could not do the same with this one. For one, It's got A LOT of similarities with Nalini Singh's Guild Hunter series from the location, to character personalities/roles, and even dialogue flow. Now I'm not saying that only one author can claim absolute rights to all those things I mentioned above, but then there has got to be some limits because one thing that most readers look out for is originality.

I went through about 25% of the book scrutinizing every other paragraph because the scenes were all VERY similar to what Ms. Singh wrote for Angel's Blood (Book 1 of Guild Hunter series).

Another thing that turned me off was the personality of Cara, who is the female "protagonist" in the story. I had to wonder about her moral compass because she describes herself as someone who wouldn't hesitate to hurt other people, "their guilt or innocence be damned", in order to protect the people she loves. And then later on she proceeds to criticize an entire race for killing. She just sounded like a huge hypocrite.

I will also point out that her best friend/Director of NADH (North American Division of Hunters) is a biased individual who is not fit for the leadership role which she has been assigned based on the fact that she mentions at one scene to pick any other operative for a dangerous mission, just not her best friend Cara. I mean what the hell kind of a director is she?

To cut this review short, I will not be finishing this book if I have to nitpick at every other detail from major character flaws to the plot being a poor imitation.
