★★★★! Broken series, book 1 of ? Quick, humorous, yet erotic read with an obsessive, troubled, sexually addicted (gynecologist) hero!

After downloading it I just meant to peek a little, but before I knew it I was pulled by the unusual, slightly humorous storyline, corky heroin and damaged hero. This is a quick read, 100+ pages.

This story is told from both the hero's and heroine's POV. Sofia Ann Parsons (mid twenties/homecare nurse-wanna-be baker/auburn hair/blue eyes) has, on a dare from her girl friends, scheduled an appointment with a gynecologist she has been crushing on at her grocery store - Dr. Daniel Fletcher, "Mr. Vagina" (thirties/gynecologist/dark hair/blue eyes).

Sofia is sweet, corky and very naive while Daniel is a troubled, dark hero, a self-proclaimed "sophisticated slut". The story immediately hints to sexual abuse in Daniel's childhood and in his attempt at pain management he is controlling his sexual addictions by pleasuring anonymous women, while denying himself. Dr. Sex-addict gynecologist, who has never been in a relationship, constantly in search of his next submissive, meets Ms. Naive Romantic. Well, if did not hint at a train wreck I don't know what would have. Needless to say their first several encounters are (humorous) disasters. While Daniel is home reprimanding himself for his sick twisted desires and needs, Sofia is at home chatting with her girl friend, falling in love... and searching the internet for ways to fix/save him.

BTW Sofia never actually got to have her examination at the doctor's office...

For me this was a quick, cute and very sexy read all baked into one. I did not realize this was going to be a series, but to me Daniel's and Sofia's story wrapped up pretty happily with a sort of cliffhanger (involving a family member) in epilogue.

The beginning starts out with so much promise: funny, quarky, not really dark- more dusk. The female MC was humorous and ditsy, and the Male MC was intriguing and reserved (he maintained that edge until I DNFed- go, Daniel! Woot!). I was all, "Hell, yeah, this is going to be a 5 star read." I was excited and smiling and intrigued and IN the story...

...& then there is a shift in the writing style. It went from smooth to chaotic and disjointed. The change is during the week (only a paragraph in the book) between when he tells her to leave and when she stomps back to his house (because that's the rational thing to do when someone tells you to LEAVE)- turning into a psycho.

My apologies in advance- I just don't know how to write this without the snarkiness. Sorry. I've read all the other reviews and I just don't understand why no one pointed this out: Sofi is the psycho of the pair.

She stomps back to his house after the week absence. He vaguely explains why HE WANTS HER OUT OF HIS LIFE. He storms out of his house to get away from her. So instead of leaving, Sofi BAKES cakes and cupcakes. As a girl who bakes... it takes hours to make one batch of cupcakes, let alone several cakes and cupcakes- fully frosted w/inspirational & institutional sayings. Plus, she had to go buy the supplies (which meant she left, and then came back), and then make DIE! DIE! DIE! cupcakes??? Am I missing something here? Did I get the wrong book at this point, did the manuscript get messed up?

The catalyst: she hears a phone ringing (in his walk-in closet, in his bedroom, in a jacket pocket with her sonic hearing from the kitchen) all the while she's trespassing like a f'n psycho, baking cakes like Crazy Crocker. A woman answers on the other side (of course)- so she starts making DIE! cupcakes and smashing wine bottles?!?
