I've been wanting to have the Complete Filmmaking Journey "Collector's Edition" for the *Harry Potter* films for a long time but didn't know about it when it was published and nowadays you'd have to rob Gringotts in order to be able to afford it. Thus, instead, I've been meaning to get at least some of the books detailing the page-to-screen process and this is the first.

It shows what the title suggests: the places the producers made come to life for the movies. The book contains 9 chapters, showing everything from the Dursley Home, every shop in Diagon Alley, all there is to see of King's Cross Station (including the Hogwarts Express of course), every nook and cranny about Hogwarts Castle, the different classrooms and grounds at Hogwarts, to Hogsmeade, the Minstry of Magic and the homes of different wizarding families.

The reader gets to see original sketches from Rowling herself as well as concept art from the designers, models for the different buildings and some early steps in the CGI process.

Moreover, this book features two extras, a little collection of Hogwarts paintings

as well as a fold-out map of Diagon Alley

(not as great as the one from the illustrated editions but still kinda cool).

The text also details how some locations (like the clock tower and courtyard) were moved around for some movies and why and gives a nice little overview.

A recommendation for fans only because it does, of course, show nothing new for those who've read the novels and/or watched the movies. But for fans, this is a nice way of getting some concept about a book adaptation. The one star I deducted was for some of the concept art being printed to fit a page which made the writing too small even for my eyes (like the caves underneath Gringotts of which I wanted to know more and which would have made a nice fold-out).
