Angela was skeptical about how genuine the ladies would be in front of others, but she'd wanted to help any woman that

she could, as a way of finally helping her own mother, who was a victim of domestic violence.

Anita Harrison, Ernestine Johnson, Toni Brown and Candace Carter have more in common than the other knows. As they listen to the other pour out their reasoning for being there, they can see themselves in their situations. As Angela finds a way to help them work through all of the pain, guilt, tears and secrets, she reveals a new light for each woman to see themselves in.
