This contemporary romance has it all: crazy stalker women, scheming mothers, polyamorous Frenchmen, erotica authors, desperate bachelors, twins, antiquities thieves, Civil War era-actors, and unrequited loves. For all of the plot complications herein: I blame it all on the sex.

See, Vi's life would be easier if she and that strapping ginger Mike Ostranski never lost their virginity to each other on graduation night. He ruined her. Just ruined her--they had been good friends until that (highly anticipated) fateful night. But hooking up and then leaving for summer camp, then college, then medical school really left Violet with abandonment issues. Now Mike's returned to Bozeman, Montana--and is good friends with Violet's twin sister Veronica--but never seeks out any contact with the gal he left behind.

Until Violet is filling in for Veronica working at Bozeman, Montana's only adult store, Goldie's. Mike's call is a plea for help. Aided by his mother, a stalker-neighbor has been trying to seduce him while he vacations up in Alaska. He wanted Veronica to come to his rescue and claim she was his girlfriend, but, you know, Violet will do.

Outraged, Violet refuses, but Mike's a charmer. And, Goldie is pressing on her to get some action--or at least some closure, for goodness sake. Soon Vi's on the red-eye to Anchorage. She's the newest guest at the Ostranski family reunion. As, Mike's fiance. Yeah, he had to up the game to keep his stalker at bay. Mike's uncle, recently retired from the military, is hosting ten guests for a week before hitting the trail as a Confederate soldier in those Civil War re-enactment tours. Oh my! He's got some quirky lines!

Meanwhile, Violet's accosted in the shower by stalker-gal, and she handles herself well. She and Mike drift into the comfortable friendship they had in high school, spending hours fishing for salmon and making up for lost time. In fact, Mike's romantic hand is forced, not only by his stalker, and interfering mother, but by his

French cousins who would like nothing better than to make Violet the filling in their man-sandwich. Oh, and who can forget Cherry Bottoms? Yeah, that's Vi's alter ego--a presumably bestselling author of erotica--something she has gone to great lengths to keep hidden.

It's a fast-paced rollicking tale of soul mates who got separated too early in their lives. Mike's never been serious about anyone since Vi, and the flip-side is true for Vi. Still, it's not all easy. While they fit physically, and chemically, Mike's devotion to his career above all things isn't fair to Violet--especially when Mike's career path seems to take a turn for New York. And Vi isn't willing to move.

[Side note: Having a history in teaching medical school, and still working in close contact with physicians, well, some of this tale doesn't hold realistic water, but few readers probably understand the career paths of podiatrists and for them this will not be troubling. For me, it was.]

In the end we get an HEA--and a coming out for Cherry. Violet's heart does get smashed in the middle and she's almost killed by a lunatic antiquities thief, but Mike kinda gets his act together just in time.

Speaking of time, usually I complain about pace being too slow. Not the case here. Sometimes I actually wished for a teeny bit more info. The way some characters were introduced and glossed over left me hanging--as if they were part of another book and I should simply know their backstory--but I didn't which left me floundering at times. In all, it's a fun read with some delicious smexytimes. Ever since OUTLANDER I'm a sucker for a strapping ginger, so I adored Mike. Particularly when he got his head on straight. People who like contemporary romance, and quirky plots with interfering family casts, will be hooked by this book.

The fourth story in the Small Town Romance series has many characters from previous stories, and it packs a punch within the pages. Yes, Goldie and her sex shop, Goldilocks play a major role in this story and of course, the Garden Gnome, George will be involved. The story is part mystery, suspense, part comedy, secrets, white lies, and romance. This is the story of high school friends and one time lovers but now ten years later, the story of Dr. Mike Ostranski and school teacher, Violet Miller.

The school year is out for summer break, and Violet is filling in at Goldilocks for her sister, Veronica when a frantic call will come from Mike needing help, first asking for Veronica and then begging Violet to come to help him out, in Anchorage, Alaska. Violet was using her time at Goldilocks to gather more info for her

word porn, not that she would do anything with it after she wrote her stories.

“Goldie was my excuse, the perfect cover for my nefarious word porn writing. My view of the world is shifting from the ABCs to XXX.”

With the insistence of Goldie and the help of Jane, Violet will leave for Alaska for a week to be the “pretend” girlfriend to Mike, but it changes at the airport to “pretend” fiancée. How are they going to pull this off without making people mad? She is already afraid of his mother, Mrs. O, and things go from crazy to unbelievable immediately. The only thing that will make this difficult is Mike is the one she has never got over. The man she gave her virginity to, and then he left.

“If being with you now is anything like high school, there may not be much pretending.”

At times, some of the situations are like a comedy of errors, but they keep everyone believing that Mike and Violet are truly engaged. Some of the family members are eccentric, then Goldie shows up and gets in the middle of the fairy-tale adventure, throw in a sex-crazed neighbor wanting Mike, and two French foreign twins who don’t speak English and hitting on Violet.

“I might not have caught a fish, but It’s possible I might have caught me a man. And maybe I just had to start reeling him in. “

“Planes, trains, and automobiles. With Goldie and Mrs. O. I would never complain about tutoring boogie-faced kids ever again.”

Once again, Goldie oversteps and gets involved with the erotic story she had Violet write and now it has been published and become an overnight success. Violet is seeing her teaching career in danger, and what will Mike think when he reads her word porn? Will he shun her and be embarrassed, or will he be impressed with her fantasy writing?

“It was working—Hook, line, and sinker. Decadent, dominant, and just a tiny bit dirty.”

The story is a fun second chance romance. You can’t help but love the sassiness of Goldie who doesn’t have a shy bone in her body, or afraid to say whatever is on her mind. While the story does have a sex scene, it isn’t overly emphasized. The romance between Mike and Violet makes this story special.

This was my first time reading Jennifer Zane and it will definitely not be the last. Zane has made a somewhat far fetched story fun to read. Violet is a mild mannered teacher who fishes and has a secret ability to write smoking hot erotica or what she refers to as creating "word porn" and Mike is a podiatrist with a well developed Alpha side. It's a little hard to believe that a grown man would need to call in reinforcements when trying to dissuade an unwanted admirer, but the story falls into place a little later when the reader finds out that there have been other forces at work in both Mike and Violet's lives. The secondary characters are interesting and I definitely plan on going back and reading the first books to get their stories. Violet is working at Goldilocks, the town's only adult store for the summer, when she takes a call from Mike and is roped into a scheme to help him fend off the over eager neighbor who has her sights on snagging herself a good looking doctor. Goldie, the owner of Goldilocks and infamous busy body encourages Violet to go out

to Alaska and see what happens. Goldie is a hoot, but you wouldn't want someone like her helping you out much though. Her brand of "helping" could be a bit much to take, but it is all done with good intentions.

Although this can be read as a stand alone, like in so many cases, the back stories of people who make an appearance would be a plus. However, not having read the other stories did not take away from my enjoyment of this book, it only made me want to go back and read them as well. I like that Mike and Violet do not fall instantly on each other and that the thing that separated them in the past is not glossed over when they come together again. This is a light, quick read that will give you a giggle and is a fun escape.
