Good Showing

I've been waiting for the Blackwood Twins book. I thoroughly enjoyed the storyline the author chose for Ryder and Ryland even if the idea of twins mating with twins is a bit too easy of a device. The author managed to stir it up a bit with the boys struggling to come to terms with the possibility of having to share the same mate when it was clearly the last thing either wanted to do. The unique disability for one of the girls was another nice change of pace. And I always like when other characters are carried onward into a series. While I don't make a habit of commenting on this particular flaw, the thing that really drop the rating of this book for me was the extremely poor editing. This isn't about typos, there were glaring instances where the twins were all turned around regarding who was with whom; often from one sentence to the next. There were enough words missing that it would take going back a couple of paragraphs to figure out what was going on. There were also several instances where a word was misspelled badly enough that it practically changed the meaning of a sentence or paragraph completely. If the editing was done with nothing more than a program like Word then the author did herself a gross disservice. I can't help but think using a professional editor or beta readers would have helped immensely.

For a reader vested in the series, you should be able to stumble through this book and appreciate it for the storyline and overall continuity. For someone hoping for a standalone, you will probably be disappointed.
