When the woman finally awakes she doesn't know who she is - she can't remember anything. With a major storm in the works, they are stuck in their cabin for a week without access to a phone. The guys come from a polyamorous family and are looking for a woman they can all share. They are also all Doms and even have a playroom in their little cabin. Emmett is the oldest brother and voice of reason - although they have all fallen in love with the woman they have named Amber (after the color of her eyes), he says they can't play with her until they know her history. After all, she might have a boyfriend or even be married with kids. So one day when Cody and Emmett are out trying to find a way into town, Amber starts to kiss Bryant and one thing leads to another. What really bugged me was that although Amber initiated things, she then kept telling Bryant they should wait but he wasn't listening. Then Cody comes home and joins in the fun. I really, really, really wanted to love this book. The pretense was amazing; 3 cowboys, Colorado, a damsel in distress, saviors, stuck in a cabin - oh the endless potential that offered. I was so excited to begin reading this, with books rolling around in my minds reference like Colter's Woman; I cheerfully tore into this book.

Alas, my overly hyped ideas of finding warmth and a loving relationship were slowly killed by a culmination of things. First, I am not a grammar nazi in the least. However, there are some basic misses of spelling and correct tense usage that gnawed at me.

The story jumps were extraordinarily jarring and so out of context I felt like I was jumping to a whole knew story at times. I am not a person that needs every single line drawn out for me, but I couldn't follow the arc of the character who one moment was lying on the ground wounded, moving towards the light, and the next minute is awake, talking, and resuming his role as a 'dom'.

Which leads me to my next catching point with this book. I am by no means a prude who cannot fathom love outside of the typical vanilla portrait drilled into every person since they understood the concept of love. I

like love stories that go outside of the contextual norm and extend my ideas or understandings of how love can work. When I reading about someone being dominate one of two things needs to transpire. One, a strong relationship between the submissive and dominate needs to be established in intricate detail, so the nuance of being submissive is fulfilled in a beautifully soulful fashion. The other option for me is to establish a sense of dominance slowly, beautifully, sensually; allowing me to sink into the idea of submitting to a person who is going to fulfill the role in a manner that allows me to believe it. Neither of those ideas transpired in this book. The 'dom' was rudimentary at best and barbaric at worst.

In this story, the heroine, Amber/Kathy said 'cowboy' far too often for me. Considering there are three of them, it seemed like a slight that never, and I do mean never ever changed. It wasn't a cutesy little term of endearment, but rather a quick burr that stuck in my ass throughout the story line.

When we get to the moments where there is supposed to be this spicy sexy, loving, intense exchange of emotions and physical combings, for lack of a better term - and I got a 5th grader version of a sexual encounter.
