First things first. **I received a digital copy of this book (via NetGalley) in exchange for an honest review.**

When I first read this novel back in February, I was convinced it warranted a four-star rating because I thoroughly enjoyed myself. I rarely read science fiction that involves aliens, and I found the setup in *Defiance Rising* to be quite intriguing and wonderfully complex. The world the author created was certainly teeming with danger and adventure. What's not to love about it? The world-building had the makings of a fantastic dystopian hit.

However, when I read it for the second time, it was only then that I realized how horribly imbalanced the sci-fi and fantasy elements were compared to the romance. The love triangle in *Defiance Rising* completely overshadowed everything else and significantly slowed down the story's momentum. It was an annoyingly monotonous back-and-forth heap of melodrama and painfully ridiculous dialogue. I was forced to endure multiple displays of possessiveness, scenes filled with whining and self-pity, and emotional outbursts that were bordering on hysterical.

Still a fan of the book, but I hope the latter installments are better.
