It works for them but has never crossed Jacklyn's mind as something for her. For the past several years, she has lived on a ranch and worked with the horses. The ranch recently burned down due to a fire caused by Jacklyn's boyfriend at the time. The fire is part of the previous book in the series but you don't have to read that one to understand what's going on.

As a teenager, Jacklyn was hired by Milo's dad who has since passed away. Milo's brothers, Eli and Sawyer, have both moved away but frequently visit.
