Angela continues surprise me throughout the book with how she handles the situation with Antonio. The level of maturity she shows when dealing with Naomi and her antics are impressive. The fact that Angela has been hurt by Antonio actions, but is still keeps going to her job every day just shows how strong of a person she is. Maria helps motivate Angela to keep going into work every day until she finally confides in her sister about how much she truly cares for him.
