It's always exciting when a new book by this author is released and this was no exception. The characters,

old and new, are fabulous and the storyline was solid and definitely not over the top.

Lincoln Knight, the eldest Knight brother, runs his own garage as well as an underground fight club. He is instantly attracted to Shania when he meets her at her cafe but isn't prepared for anything more than one night. She on the other hand admits to the attractiveness of Lincoln but also to his antagonist, annoying mannerisms and so begins a situation where barbs are thrown rather than kisses and hugs.

The story is told in two different time stages, necessary to explain the background to Shania and her problem. But it also helps to build a clearer character profile of Shania. She has an inner strength that helps her to stand up for herself but might get her into a bit of trouble too or that could be the touch of sass she owns as well. The underlying issue Shania has is slowly revealed as the past is and we find why it is she is so desperate to find Nicolai.

Lincoln is an opinionated, straight shooter who is also a hard working man dedicated to friends and his brothers. His past has shaped him too and this has caused him a lot of unrest. One thing we witness quite a bit is that he is not afraid to stand up for what he believes in and isn't quick to judge others for their pasts.

I enjoyed this story because it wasn't your usual enemies to lovers, there is a slightly different element to it and of course getting to meet up with old characters and meet new ones is fun too.

I've been excited to jump into the *Rumbin' Knights* series after meeting the Knight brothers in the *Iron Fury MC* series. Lincoln is the oldest, but they are all broken to some degree.

The author really tortured me in the telling of this story. She doled out bits at a time using alternating past/present and multiple POV. The flashbacks/memories were how I learned about what caused *her* to seek out the Knight brothers and the bikers. She asked for their help, without giving them many details. Nor did she give them to me. Nope, we all had to wait as the story unfolded painfully slow, and my imagination went crazy with the possibilities.

What was obvious from the beginning was that Lincoln is a gorgeous alpha asshole who had women falling all over themselves to be treated like shit for the privilege of riding or sucking his cock. He is rude and arrogant and totally unapologetic. And yes, I still liked him.
