The story is about a young boy, Fisher Shoemaker, who discovers something weird in the woods while at a survival camp. Don't ask me why, but I was sure it would be a horror story. Maybe it's because of these few lines at the end of the blurb: 'They try to convince themselves it's nothing. But it's not. Whatever made the unearthly screeching will find them. To escape is critical.' So I might as well set things straight right away; if you're looking for nightmares, or even just goose bumps, look away. While this is a fun read, it's definitely not horror.

One of the things I enjoyed about the story is that even if our three friends, Fisher, Sara, and Hingy are young teenagers, they are not stupid.
