This book is really well done. You feel as fuzzy and uncertain as Tina as you read through her bizarre dream sequences that are sometimes dreams and sometimes not. When an old lover (and dream jumper) walks back into her life, ten months after her husband vanished on a routine surfing trip, he feels the need to help her find closure. What follows is a pretty serpentine story, with lots of twists. I anticipated some of them, but some caught me completely by surprise. I won't go into details, you have to read it for yourself.

Kim Hornsby's "The Dream Jumper's Promise" is a fantastic, compelling novel. It straddles the boundaries between genres - it's got elements of romance, mystery, suspense and also the supernatural, and the author brings them all together very satisfyingly.

The book tells the story of Tina Greene, a dive instructor on Maui. When we meet her, she's going through hell. Her husband's been dead for a year - or at least she thinks he's dead. He disappeared while surfing, and his wallet and pieces of his board have been found, but no body. But Tina's not completely sure - she still holds out hope he might be alive, and she's having strange recurring dreams about him. If that weren't bad enough, her dive shop is on the brink of failure, which isn't helped by the fact that Tina can't bring herself to get back in the water herself.

At her lowest point, an old flame shows up on Maui - Jamey Dunn. They had a brief affair, before he suddenly broke it off and left Tina, years ago. Jamey's not "just" an old flame, though - he's got plenty of secrets, the main one being that he has the supernatural talent to "jump" into other people's dreams. Can Jamey and Tina reconnect? Can he use his gift to help Tina figure out what really happened to her husband and get closure? And can Tina hang on to the last shreds of her sanity long enough to do it?

The author writes in a clear and strong voice. She's created a believable and sympathetic heroine in Tina - a woman who's going through the worst experiences of her life and sometimes can't tell what's reality and what's a dream - but she never stops fighting. It's impossible not to both admire and root for her. Jamey is equally well drawn, and the author fills their world with interesting and memorable secondary characters as well.

What impressed me the most about the book, though, was the way that the author really brought Maui to life. Even though I've never been to Hawaii, I could picture everything perfectly through her vivid and loving descriptions. The author does a fantastic job of making Maui not merely a setting for the action, but a character in its own right, and that's something that is very rarely pulled off as well as it is here.

I'd highly recommend this book - it's an entertaining book that won't let you put it down.
