

Hiyori finds out the difference between shinkis and gods when Yato explains the dangers of Yukine giving in to his dark side. We also get a fun scene to introduce Kofuku Ebisu and her shinki that leads to misunderstandings thanks to Yato (he is a funny guy for such a loser.) We also find out a little something about Yato's pass through idle chat in Ebisu's shop before his past finally catches up to him and he has to fight the girl on the cover and she won't be satisfied till he is dead.
