Book 2 of this series sees Jamie Roscoe pining a little for what his brother Ryan has with husband Anthony and daughter Marissa. Jamie is the EVP of the property development division of Roscoe industries he doesn't love the job but it has its perks. He has to assess one of their properties up in the mountains that has sat wasted and undeveloped for a few years and comes across Morgan Patrick who's lost everything after coming out to his homophobic father, squatting there, but pretending to be a buyer to save face. Jamie hates this family especially Roman the father who's tried every trick in the book to put Roscoe industries out of business and stole Jamie's internship out from under him with Morgan's help ruining the career he really wanted. Jamie is suspicious and thinks something is off about the whole thing. Sparks and anger ignite between the pair and they end up having a hate f##k. Morgan is dealing drugs and owes money to his dealer Tim Collins and is desperately trying to sell his stash to pay his debts but gets badly beaten and robbed and ends up in hospital and is treated by Jamie's cousin Philip. Collins sends one of his goons up to the cabin for the money but Morgan is short and knows if he can't come up with the rest in a couple of days he's a dead man. Morgan arranges another bogus house viewing with Jamie and they get stranded up in the cabin during a severe storm and realise their feelings weren't just about hate but passion and a long standing attraction and finally talk about their past actions and some of the consequences and make love this time not hate. Jamie ventures into the storm trying for cell reception but ends up injured and knocked out and Morgan has to try and get him half a mile down the mountain in all of the treacherous conditions to Jamie's abandoned car. They make it to the hospital both in need of treatment, Jamie defends his feelings to his family and Morgan gets a heartbreakin surprise and another one when Collins goons come to the hospital, so he bolts back up the mountain to the cabin for his gear, unknowingly followed by goons who beat him to a pulp and Morgan just lies there waiting to die as the cabin burns.
