When Sugar turns 18, Cash sets his sights on her to be his by starting with his punishments of her and restricting her activities. Sugar is perfectly okay with this but horrified that she craves this attention from him. Finally, when she is 21, he makes his move and makes Sugar his lover and slave.

The book takes us back and forth from the present, in which she is 27, to when she was 21 and became his lover, then 24 when she left him, revealing bits on what happened and why, and where they are today. While mostly from Sugar's POV, like most Carolyn Faulkner books, it switches POV with no warning and you find yourself part-way through a paragraph to realize it has changed

Altogether, this is one of her better books. It isn't a non-con but more of an acceptance of what you want and need regardless of what society thinks. Sugar's friend Willow sums it up perfectly in explaining that to her and finally makes her see there is nothing wrong with her for needing what she wants!

Cash is the kind of Dom I could really get into. His brand of domestic discipline is delicious. The spanking, anal and orgasm control is right up my alley. What caused me issues was the dynamics between the two. Sugar seemed to be inordinately immature. She is constantly conflicted and aggravating with her wavering. The reader isn't sure why she left Cash. When the reason is unveiled, it makes a reader go, W.T.H? It is at least consistent with her immaturity.

The characters here are underdeveloped and it is overwhelms the BDSM so that it's hard to ignore. In addition, the editing is all off. There were parts of the story where the words were striked out. How is this possible? I paid for a book which isn't fully finished? On top of it there were other editing errors? This brought the book's overall quality down. I second my friend Mrs. Joseph, Ms. Faulkner needs an editor. Or perhaps her Dom needs to give her a few intense spanking sessions too.
