How will he survive? That kept me turning pages. The villain in this is his true love's father who is already very wealthy but will stop at nothing to increase his holdings. Rafe falls in love with his daughter and the only means for support he can think of is to join the Confederate Army. They marry but keep it secret but their chance at happiness is thwarted when Rafe's military orders keep him separated from his wife.

Though it has good characters, and great historical details (I learned a few things I didn't know about injustices in the South during that time), I felt the book sagged due to plodding pacing and continual frustration caused by keeping the two main characters apart.
