I was bound and determined; I am going to give a bad rating for this book! In fact I have given zero stars and am consciously leaving a bad review. My 2 reasons are as follows:

Cliffhanger; the book ends on a cliffhanger and is actually a prequel for the next (hopefully) full-length book Misleading blurb; it says 'a crying baby left at her apartment' which led me to believe someone left abandoned their child with her; that is not true. The H meets her with some kids and assumes she is a mother, which she does not deny. It is in a later scene when she is babysitting the kids from earlier and another little girl; H assumes that baby is her fourth child.

Apart from this the main characters are engaging and the story seemed to be shaping up nicely but for the sudden cliffhanger

Also, the author has written some erotica in the book; as H and h say, they are not in the BDSM lifestyle but H is adventurous while h wants to experiment and be free, whatever that means

And the biggest stupidity; apparently H and h chat on a dating app under assumed names; H gets to know h's name and realises they are already chatting but he knows she is a bit uncomfortable with dirty talk; so what does he do?
