Falling For Her is a short story in the Rose Harbor series by popular American author, Debbie Macomber. It is written from the perspective of Jo Marie Rose's cranky handyman and carpenter, Mark Taylor. When his workshop bench collapses onto his leg, breaking it, Mark finds himself somewhat dependent on Jo Marie, and he doesn't like it one bit! When he analyses his feelings, he realises he has fallen for her, and decides that cannot continue.

What a disappointment this short story is! Apart from giving the reader Mark's perspective of events, in particular, the broken leg incident, it imparts nothing new, nothing that was not covered in the first three novels. And short, it is, at merely 30 pages, the balance being made up with a preview of the fourth novel in the series, Silver Linings. Diehard Macomber fans may not object to paying for this snippet, but to many readers this will smack of a money-making exercise. Save your hard earned money for something with more substance!
