I'm a huge Chase Rice fan and found this book when it came up under a Chase Rice hashtag on Instagram. I immediately fell in love with the playlist Barbara Justice has in Spotify (I actually made my own exactly the same on Apple Music). I could not wait to start the story. The song Jack Daniels and Jesus by Chase Rice is so haunting and has so much emotion I needed more of that in the telling of Sky's "demons". His mom being hit by a drunk driver and him blaming himself was just not enough for me, especially having that revealed so early on! I'm currently 22% into the story (chapter 12) and am so frustrated with the lack of angst or heart ache I was hoping from based off the description and play list.

Things I couldn't get over:

Poorly developed characters

Dialogue awkward and over done

No keeping emotions bottled up...something you expect from two damaged people. They just laid it all out way too early.

Way too much detail that was unnecessary.

The author revealed too much with the internal dialogue of both characters. Going back and forth between both in one scene gives way too much away and makes it boring for the reader. I wish we had whole chapters where we didn't know what the other character was thinking or feeling in a scene. Build up the love story a little more.

I'm normally not a quitter, but I was so frustrated with the dialogue I just had to walk away! Sorry!
