The first 7 chapters felt like I was reading inner dialogue (much like volumes 20 and 21). Why let Avery talk over and over about events that will hopefully take place? Why drag it out, make the book thicker and not give an epilogue or actual closure to Sean and Avery's story? Will Avery survive without Sean? Who's on what team? Who's good and who's bad? People are miraculously alive that are supposed to be dead. Storylines from past books aren't lining up. And this volume seems to be dragging out the inevitable

conclusion to Sean and Avery's story.

The Arrangement 23 ends at 87% and made me even more disheartened after following the story for so many years. Was it a good read?
