Underlying their relationship is Evie's big secret. This is somewhat driving the story as almost every hurdle they have to overcome has to do with her past, her fears and her insecurities. At times she's able to stand up to Adam, and those are the scenes when she deserves a high five.

Wow. I just finished this book and I'm hooked. I need the sequel now...I mean right now. I usually read erotic romance expecting hot sex, not much plot, but pure entertainment. While the sex in this book was hot, it was almost inconsequential to the story and really only served to show the immediate and all-consuming attraction between the main characters, Adam and Evie. He is intrigued and puts immediate moves on her but both have secrets that neither is eager to share. Adam is a big time real estate entrepreneur from a wealthy family and Evie is an artist and art teacher who is/has been rather tormented.

This is the first in a series and does leave the couple hanging. I found their relationship rather unhealthy but can't put my finger on just one reason. He is a dominant alpha male who expects more than he is willing to give wanting to "take care of" her and yet unwilling to share as much as he feels he is entitled to hear from her. She is either depressed and apathetic or fully engaged/angry. In fact, they are both angry quite often.

It was a steamy read but it left me...wanting. It was told in first person from Evie's viewpoint and I think if I were her I would have been fed up, as she seemed at times, by the hovering of her friend Tina, her mother and Adam. I think that I wanted them to show more depth of feeling but being cut off as they were it probably was too much to expect unless they are willing to open up and trust and communicate.

I initially requested an ARC of this book simply because I liked the cover. The description held promise, but I was completely unfamiliar with the author and a bit skeptical since it appeared to be self published. While I've read some fantastic self published works, I think most people would agree it can be a bit of a toss up. I was certainly willing to at least give it a try. At first I admit I wasn't a fan of the writing style. It felt very abrupt, maybe too concise for fiction. I was kind of interested in the scene playing out and the characters, so I kept reading. I found their arguments to be repetitive at times, as though they were forever discussing the same issues without ever really finding resolution. I didn't feel emotions. For a bank robbery and to be as scared as the heroine claims she was, I didn't feel her fear. It didn't feel real.

Hero and heroine bump into each other after the bank robbery incident. And he has a pretty blonde with him, who says.

Baby, let's go already. There's not much worth seeing here," she purrs.

What I liked was Adam's character. His character was intriguing, and I loved his bossiness. His character was appealing.

Adam wants to possess me? To own me? My thoughts echo in my head. I think we've established he already does. May I remind you of the fitting room incident?

"It means everyone can be bought. Everyone has a price," he says angrily.

As always, he's overwhelming me, unsettling the fragile control I work hard to maintain.

"Of course I care. Your insecurities are clouding your judgment if you can't see that I care about you. But I won't be with someone I can't trust."

I hated a few things, but I will start with this — the heroine She leaves him, so can't cry about it. Your lost is someone else's gain. But, it isn't what she thinks. Adam is a well-written Hero.

He was going on a date! I hate that my body trembles with unhindered mortification.

While reading this book, it made me think of Gideon and Eva from the crossfire series, except nowhere near as HOT. I disliked the heroine. She is annoying, appears to be weak, and entirely too insecure for my liking.

Although I liked the Hero, his perspective didn't exist. So, not one time was the reader inside his head, which really sucked! It sucked because I read twenty-two chapters told by an insecure heroine when Adam is what kept me reading.

The book was interesting, and the secrets the characters are hiding will most likely have readers curious. But, this is not my cup of tea.

I will not pay to read the next two books, because I didn't enjoy this one too much. It was not one of those books that when I stopped reading; I wanted to hurry up and pick it back up. Now, if they were enrolled in Kindle select, I might have continued with this series. But, I will not buy the next two books.

Mainly because I do not like books that are told by one person. I like getting in both main characters head.

Also, the bickering at the end between the main characters annoyed me. I am not a fan of back and forth, and with the heroine coming off as insecure I can only imagine how much push and pull will continue as this series moves forward. This was such a dark and twisty read for me. Generally it's not the type of book I would actively seek out but every once in while (I'm told) that it's good to step outside your comfort zone and experience something outside the norm. Well, Waking to Black is definitely that for me. My feelings about this one are all over the place. It gets three stars because although I couldn't put it down and the story hooked me, I can't get over what an incredible a-hole Adam was. And although I currently have a love/hate relationship with Adam, I still want to read how this all ends. Curiosity killed the cat and all that jazz.

Eve and Adam were both so emotionally messed up but somehow manage to make me root for them. Adam was a complete jerk, unapologetic and arrogant beyond belief but towards the end he sheds his detached emotionless mask and I can't quite give up all hope that he isn't the giant a-hole he so convincingly portrays. Much like Eve, he is a fascinating enigma. Right when I think there is no going back for him, he manages to turn the tables and share something or do something for Eve that shows he isn't such a prick after all.

Eve was such a contradiction - one minute she was hurting and vulnerable, the next she was throwing caution to the wind and diving head first into situations so reckless it was a bit frightening. Sometimes I wanted to shake her and slap some sense into her but the more I read the more complex she became. I don't condone her actions but for her character, her actions made crazy sense. I don't understand it myself but these two are like a train wreck I can't look away from.

The romance is not the cute adorable kind. It's more of an emotional roller coaster or a really intense and soul crushing game of truth or dare. There is a lot of Adam demanding and Eve submitting. With all the push/pull between them I felt like I got whiplash with every crazy encounter between the MCs. It was basically a yo-yo of ups and downs and no mellow in between.

Eve is a young girl scarred inside and out and her insecurities rear their ugly heads constantly. She meets Adam when they both get caught in a failed bank robbery and when she unknowingly catches Adam's attention, she isn't prepared for the intense and all consuming feelings that Adam brings out in her. But after closing herself off emotionally for the last three years, the spark between them is too tempting for Eve to resist. I don't know yet if I admire her for her courage or feel uneasy that she gave in so quickly (and with no fight) to Adam. Because trust me, she takes a lot of crap from him and somehow manages to turn the other cheek. It is truly mind boggling.

As for Adam, he is a control freak that takes what he wants when he wants it and he's decided that Eve is it for him, for now. He was such a cold unfeeling bastard half the time and ran so hot and cold with Eve that I honestly thought of throwing in the towel because he was just so aggravating. But it speaks to the author's skills that she crafted such complicated and broken characters that I somehow came to care about, because I'm invested in Adam and Eve and I find myself wishing they will eventually be able to break down all their walls and let themselves fall in love and actually be happy about it.

This book is not for everyone.
