Beautiful Girl, as the title states, is a modern day retelling of Beauty and the Beast. Mason Beast is the younger son in the Beast family and determined to bring continued success to his family's high end department store. At a store opening, he sees Charisma Chu and is instantly fascinated by her. When his older brother manages to insult her and her mother (she's the CEO of a cosmetic company) he and his father need to damage control.

Callum Beast is the older son, content to be the face and social media star for his family's company. He doesn't understand why no one found his remarks funny. When he's in a horrific accident that mars his face, he gets a chance to learn who he is and what he's willing to fight for.

Charisma Chu is an MBA student and works for her mom's company. When fate throws her in the path of both Mason and Callum, she finds more than expected.

Told from the first perspective and switching between. Mason, Callum, and Charisma, Beautiful Girl retells this fairy tale classic with a twist.
