But that's where Marie waves her magna-angst magic wand. Things seem good between Layla and Ollie but she senses something is off. But she has school on her mind, and wants to graduate from college and she is blind to things she should be seeing. Jared and Ollie are still bitter rivals and their confrontations are behind Layla's back.

While Ollie should be on top of the world he is still insecure about Layla and Jared's influence on her. This causes him to do stupid things that have the potential to destroy his career, his relationship with Layla and his health.
