More tom-boy than vixen with an attitude to rival Drae's, Tori is hiding out after a scandal blew up in her face less than a year ago. Sparks fly and these two instantly clash, the chemistry is insane and they can't be in a room together for longer than five minutes without a fight ensuing. But when forced to leave town to work on a job together, the gloves have to come off and the results are more than a little surprising. But when what happens in Vegas follows them home, everyone is affected and Draegyn has a decision to make if he doesn't want to lose Tori from his life completely.
