Secret Agent Secretary is Melissa Cutler's second book in her ICE: Black Ops Defender series and also the second book I've read from her as well. When I looked back at my review of book one to refresh myself I noticed a sticking point with me was the lack of romance in it. While I don't think that has really necessarily changed, the constant action, flirting and slow warm up to the eventual sex at the end of the book made this a page turner. In fact I read this over the course of two sittings only because my family wouldn't leave me alone. This could have easily been a one sitting read had I had the opportunity to do so.

Avery has been working at the ICE, San Deigo office as a secretary for a few years and she's damn good at her job. Though this is certainly not what she dreams of doing, she's content enough to stay on the fringes of the action instead of getting into the mix. When the elusive Agent Reitano calls her on New Years Eve to email him a highly classified file and keep quiet about it, she's curious as to why but her instincts tell her to

help him. Unfortunately his computer isn't working and the paper file is missing so the only way to get him the information is by telling him about her photographic memory and recite him the information. When she arrives at the hotel he's supposedly doing surveillance at she unwillingly gets thrown into a action packed battle for her life as bad guys emerge from every dark corner to take them down.

Agent Ryan Reitano has much more at stake in his search for the sole remaining brother of a criminal empire. Nothing he can share with the curvy, surprisingly agile, secretary who may be a double agent but as they run through the streets of San Deigo he begrudgingly admits she has some skills he didn't see coming. When it becomes clear she's not behind the leak of information in the office she becomes an integral part in helping Ryan turn the tables on everyone involved.

There is so much action in this I basically sped through the book at break neck speed. It moved the plot along really well and gave Avery multiple opportunities to shine as she worked side by side with Ryan. The peppered in comedy was a breath of fresh air and it definitely gave the characters a more human quality and kept me chuckling throughout. Avery loves gadgets and to actually see them in the hands of a hot secret agent has her melting all over herself. I loved how Ryan never exactly smiled at Avery's retorts but his lips twitched an awful lot and his emotions shone clear in his eyes.

The constant flirting made the lack of sex in this one acceptable to me. Though Avery and Ryan don't actually get together until very, VERY, late in the book, the gun fondling, body fondling and back and forth banter gave this book a very sexy feel...without the actual....uhhh....penetration. If adventure is what you crave in a story and also want lots of sexual tension, then the ICE: Black Ops Defenders miniseries by the very talented Melissa Cutler will satisfy both requirements. The first book in the miniseries remains one of my all-time favorites, and SECRET AGENT SECRETARY is definitely added to the list. From high-speed car chases to ruthless thugs with guns, the danger is never-ending plus almost always physically threatening and not knowing the outcome always upped my fear for the main couple. What split-second decisions these two frequently made could mean either living or dying, and I so hoped they would make the right choice as I truly loved Ryan and Avery. Melissa Cutler ingeniously brings a suspenseful book about spies and romance to life with riveting cleverness.

Since Avery Meadows works as a secretary for Immigration and Customs Enforcement in San Diego, she has reached one of her goals. Although she is not out in the field, working at the ICE office does let her assist national security. A current case involves an international criminal, and she would love to actively aid in catching him yet knows that possibility is near zero. Before leaving the office late on New Year's Eve, she receives a phone call from their newest agent, Ryan Reitano. To get the requested information to him, she must go to the location where he is undercover.

When Ryan sees Avery, he cannot help but wonder if she is the person who compromised his mission to find Chiara. Before he can even question her, they are shot at and have to flee. Avery never thought her quest to experience the adventuresome side of ICE would ever come true. Now she is right in the middle of gun battles and is running for her life with a very tempting man. Ryan is completely stunned as to how competent Avery turns out to be, whether confronting hit men or just using her quick mind. He is very determined to stop Chiara from ever hurting anyone else, but it looks like he will have extra help in the form of one very knowledgeable secretary.

The scenes featuring the unique heroine in SECRET AGENT SECRETARY are constantly entertaining because of her independent way of thinking. Avery is also exceptionally intelligent, and watching her shrewdly implement any plan was often very impressive. I certainly could never have come up with many of her ideas, and the way in which she carried out a number of them had me cheering her on. She is not someone who just stands back and watches, but repeatedly jumps into the situation and does anything to turn the circumstances in the favor of the good guys. Her responses to genuine weapons caused me to smile, and all her real life links to spies is really fascinating.

From the instant Avery and Ryan team up, the story becomes doubly enthralling. Though he is more reserved as he keeps many secrets from her at first, he is certainly intriguing and his inner thoughts let the reader know many of his true intentions. One of his motivations is kept hidden for much of the book, and its disclosure is absolutely unforeseen and made things very dicey near the end. Although plenty of risky incidents keep cropping up, there are still times when sharp-witted comments are made and cause the moment to be a little more lighthearted. Melissa Cutler has a knack for creating cunning retorts, and I chuckled loudly over what either Ryan or Avery said on several occasions. While they may have been on the run for most of the book, they did find time to explore the sexual attraction between them and the encounter is sensually intense. A few characters from the first book make an appearance, and they are just as likable once again. There is another upcoming book in the ICE: Black Ops Defenders miniseries and I am so thankful. SECRET AGENT SECRETARY has perilous danger, unanticipated intrigue, fervent passion and amusing humor.

Secret Agent Secretary is a standalone book. However, it does contain small spoilers from the first book, Tempted Into Danger.

Agent Ryan Reitano is back in Melissa Cutler's latest ICE: Black Ops Defenders book, Secret Agent Secretary. This time, Ryan is solo and working in the San Diego office of ICE, trying to figure out who the mole in ICE is. He's also still trying to catch his archenemy, Vincenzo Chiara.

Avery Meadows has been an ICE Secretary for the last six years. Avery is a MAJOR spy movie/book fan. I'm talking she has a crazy obsession. In fact, she took the job at ICE to help live out some of her bucket list fantasies. However, this occupation is one she keeps from her pacifist family.

For the past six months, Avery has been admiring Ryan from afar. This New Year's Eve, things are going to change. Trying to help Ryan out, Avery stumbles into an ambush where Ryan is the target. With shots being fired and bad guys dropping dead, Avery rises to the challenge to be the partner Ryan needs, in more ways than one.

She tries not to let it get to her, but she has to wonder why he's so closed off from her. That all changes on NYE (New Years Eve) when she's STILL in the ICE office late, as in after 9:00pm late. She's trying to get into her slinky HOT PINK dress, which cost her a mint, but can't quite get the zipper up! Leave it to resourceful Avery to make a paperclip chain hooked up to the zipper to save the night! A sudden call to her office phone direct from HIS cell phone changes EVERYTHING for her!

After receiving the call, she has to wonder why him, and why from his personal cell phone, not his agent phone? He wants a very classified file E-mailed to him right away. Well after that things only get more complicated for Avery. Nothing is going right, Agent Reitano's computer is on the fritz, the paper file is completely MIA and to top it off...she KNOWS exactly what's in the file he needs. When Ryan is on his “surveillance mission” things start to go wrong starting with the arrival of the goons at his hideout, then the arrival of a sexy blonde in a hot pink dress, but wait that can’t be the demure, and reserved ICE secretary...but it certainly is. Why is she there? Is she the double agent in the ICE office, or clueless about whats going on?? He approaches her and drags her away from her drink and the festivities only to have shots fired right at them! The hired goons are on their tail. Trouble only seems to be after them, but when Ryan get into trouble, Avery has a new side to her Ryan never knew about that gets him out of trouble, but gets Avery all mixed up in his affairs and his investigation. Not to mention that if the goons boss identifies her and start to go after her, she’d be as good as dead. Ryan takes it upon himself to safeguard her and get her away from trouble.

Avery is much sharper then Ryan ever knew, even from his transfer to the ICE office and some intel about his previous ICE mission what wasn’t even explicitly detailed in the case file. Some of his answers don’t add up for her, and when she finally gets here chance to grill him, she has to wonder whats really going on? When things take on even a more dangerous spin, she has to start making decisions she knows may cost her everything. But without Ryan she’d never have realized that she’s not fulfilling her bucket list or her desires. The rest only balloons from here. She finds herself running from the goons in her prized possession a black Porsche 911 Carrera!

When her baby takes a beating, but still keeps going she turns into a Dannika Patrick of ICE and drives like a pro, saving her and Ryan from trouble again! Ryan starts to see the many delicate layers to Avery and why she’s shied away from love after being hurt. But their not out of trouble yet! It seems to follow them everywhere they go, even when it drags Ryan’s family into danger, and into hiding it doesn’t escape. It leaves Ryan with no choice but to call in his old ICE team – Diego and Alicia to help take his family and Avery to safety so he can complete HIS life mission.

Will he send her away because he cares for her, and knows he can’t be the man she needs, even when their chemistry is screaming at them to be together? Can Ryan get Avery to go with Diego and Alicia, and will he go against his commanders orders to complete his mission? Or does what they have be enough to trust her to help him fulfill his mission and get them together? To find out you’ll have to read the book!

I love Melissa’s writing style. With this being a romantic suspense series you know the pressure builds for the first 4/5ths of the book before it goes...BOOM! and everything comes full turn. She doesn’t disappoint in the second story of her series and I found I fell in love with Avery and Ryan more then I did with Diego and Vanessa! Avery is such a strong heroine, but didn’t know she was missing out on what makes her career fulfilling until it involved her. When she has to be brave, she doesn’t hesitate to use her resources and help out any way she can. And with Ryan she’s seeing what the life of an ICE agent is all about. Ryan is a strong and focused hero, he’s lived his life surrounded by nothing but work to keep him going.
