These really are some of the most clean of the genre, for what it's worth. No crazy innuendo, nothing too graphic, though GK doesn't dance around what can happen in a kidnapping.

I especially loved how the author covers the EMOTIONAL and mental impact that the events in the Falconer's lives has had on each one.

Adults reading might get caught up on the slight "grown-ups are dumb" trope that shows itself in bits, but really, it made sense in light of the aforesaid mental and emotional impact that had occurred on the parents, and even the agents.

All in all, a great series. Everest is still my favorite of Korman's, but this one has definitely snagged the second spot.
