This is the story of Rane a badass werewolf and his innocent mate Kirby (a name that I totally hate because of the video game persona so I called her Kim throughout).

You can see my problem here, right?

Kim/Kirby had a special ability to communicate and somewhat control animals and minions. A skill that would prove most useful to the group of Werewolves and Soldiers that are trying to defend all of humanity.
